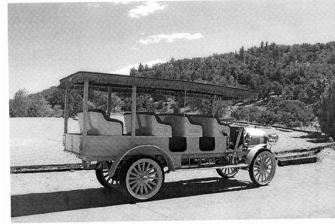
The play runs Friday and Saturday nights at 8:00 PM and Sundays at 2:00 PM through August 8th.
